INTERIM COMBAT REPORT

1. The enemy persistently defended the features along the axes leading to Srebrenica. They offered particularly strong resistance at the Divljakinja, Bojna, Kostur and Alibegovac features. They fired all their available weapons.
2. On 9 July 1995, our units carried out a fierce attack along the axes of Zeleni Jadar – Srebrenica, Pribojevići village – Podravanje village and Kvarac – Srebrenica and reached the Divljakinja – Olovine – tt /trig point/ 684 - Živkovo Brdo –Alibegovac line, thus separating the enclaves of Žepa and Srebrenica, carried out the immediate task and created conditions for extending the attack towards Srebrenica. The especially important features that were occupied today are Živkovo Brdo and Alibegovac.
3. Decision for further operations:  
Taking advantage of the success achieved, regroup the forces and carry out a vigorous and decisive attack towards Srebrenica.
4. Conduct of UNPROFOR forces:  
The UNPROFOR forces at the checkpoints in Slapovići village and Bučje village surrendered fully to our forces with all their weapons and equipment, and asked for our protection. Ten (10) UNPROFOR soldiers from the UNPROFOR checkpoint in Bučje village have been /?sent to/ and accommodated in Milići, while five soldiers from the checkpoint in Slapovići have been accommodated in Bratunac. UNPROFOR forces from the base in Potočari village did not intervene at the checkpoints or attack our forces.
5. Requests:  
We ask for reinforcement /?the size of a battalion/ and replenishment in ammunition and fuel.
