Daily combat report

To: COMMAND OF THE DRINA CORPS

1. During the day, the enemy tried to break through - or withdraw from the enclave in the Milačevići-Jaglići-Bokčin Potok direction and further on towards Tuzla and Kladanj.
2. Our forces are mopping up the enclave and preventing the enemy from breaking through in the above-mentioned direction.
3. The state of combat readiness in the brigade's area of responsibility is good.
4. The state of morale and security is unchanged, since the previous report.
5. Logistics support is functioning satisfactorily.
We will submit details of consumption of ammunition and fuel later.
6. There have been no wounded or injured.
7. The transport of Turkish population (Muslim refugees) from the village of Potočari towards Kladanj is in progress. A large number (10,000) of refugees are expecting to be transported from Potočari to Kladanj.
